University Freshman Academic Scholarships	Students are considered for merit-based scholarships based on a combination of grade point average and standardized test score (ACT or SAT)	Have all application credentials on file in Office of Admission by May 1	Awards typically start at \$500	No limit (R)
University Tuition Scholarship for Historically Underrepresented Students	Demonstrate financial need as established by the FAFSA. Other factors in determining eligibility include academic achievement (minimum 3.0 GPA, 20 or higher ACT or 920 or higher SAT critical reading plus math), race/ethnicity, location of high school attended, state or Ohio county of residence, commitment and contribution to diversity and/or alternative measures of academic achievement	Have all application credentials on file in the Office of Admission by Jan. 15. Complete separate application. File the FAFSA by March 1	Instructional/general fees	Limited number (R)
BG Success Scholarship	3.0 GPA or 20 or higher ACT or 920 or Higher SAT (critical reading plus math); non-Ohio resident	Have all application credentials on file in the Office of Admission by Jan. 15	One-half off nonresident fee (current value \$3,654)	No limit (R)
Falcon Soars Access Scholarship Grant	3.0 GPA and have received an Ohio College Opportunity Grant	Have all application credentials on file in the Office of Admission by Jan. 15. File the FAFSA by March 1	Matches Ohio College Opportunity Grant (\$2,731 proposed maximum)	No limit (R)
